

Clean Coastal, Eat Local

Checklist for your cleanup

Before the cleanup

- Register your event: Find a cleanup location and set a date at ShorelineCleanup.ca/lead
Be sure to name your cleanup: Clean Coastal, Eat Local + *Your Custom Name.*
This ensure that we will know you are participating in this event
- Complete a site visit prior to your cleanup:
Make sure it is suitable for your solo or household cleanup
Is there enough litter? Is it too busy to maintain social distancing?
- Carefully review the municipality information on your cleanup event page (a PDF on the right side of the cleanup event page)
Some municipalities have suspended cleanups at this time
- You can find any other resources you need on [your account Dashboard](#) on the shoreline cleanup website.
- Gather your cleanup and safety supplies:

Shoreline Cleanup, Youth2Sea and Ocean Wise do not provide supplies

During the cleanup

- Track your litter finds on a Shoreline Cleanup Litter Data Card or directly on your cleanup event page on your via your smart phone
- Wrap up: weigh your trash, send any photos to shoreline.cleanup@ocean.org or tag us in your photos on social media!

After your cleanup

- Please make sure to submit your Litter Data on your event page. You will not be eligible to receive a gift card if you do not do this.
- Be sure to also submit your Summary Data on your event page, right below the Litter Data button. You will not be eligible to receive a gift card if you do not do this as well.
- We will email you at the email address used to sign up for your cleanup to confirm cleanup details and send your gift card information.

Event guidelines and logistics

Timing

Your cleanup must take place March 1st to March 31st 2021, inclusive.

Location

Only cleanups in Metro Vancouver are eligible to participate in the Clean Coastal, Eat Local event. Your cleanup does not need to be on a beach. River, lake, wetland, trail, storm drain, or green space cleanups are also eligible. You can add a new location on the Shoreline Cleanup website.

Litter Data

You must submit cleanup Litter Data and cleanup Summary Data to the Great Canadian Shoreline Cleanup website to be eligible to receive a gift card. You must collect a minimum of 10 lbs or shoreline litter or 50 pieces of shoreline litter.

Group size

Cleanups must be solo or household groups only. Groups must follow regional health guidelines as directed by the provincial health officer.

Gift cards

Gift cards are limited to one per household. All gift cards will be \$50. To receive your gift card you need to have submitted your cleanup Litter Data and cleanup Summary Data to the Great Canadian Shoreline Cleanup website. If you need assistance with this process please reach out to shoreline.cleanup@ocean.org. Contact youth@ocean.org for assistance acquiring your gift card. Your gift card will be to a sustainable restaurant near your cleanup location. Gift cards are available while supplies last.
